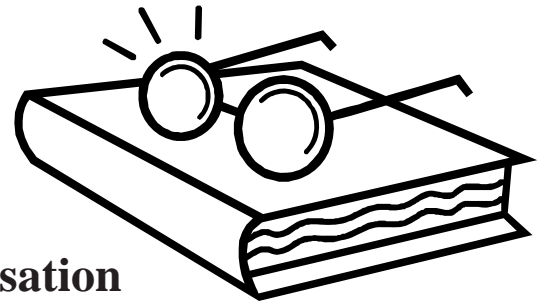


What I'm reading & why it matters
