What is The Next Step Café?

This informal weekend retreat is a socially comfortable and inviting way for Catholic young adults, ages 18-35, to discern God's calling in their life and the next step God is inviting them to take.

With a theology of vocation that honors the whole person, the **Next Step Café** helps young adults make sense of the question, "Have you considered becoming a priest?" or "a religious," or "Are you thinking about marriage?" It removes terror from the possibility that one might be called by God to celibate life, or to Christian single life, or to a genuinely Christ-centered married life.

Most importantly, this retreat helps young adults to distinguish "calling" from "career," and the noise of the world from the subtle movement of the Holy Spirit. The **Next Step Café** offers young adults a workable process to discern God's calling in a way that really honors who they are and the many ways God has gifted them to participate uniquely in God's mission—which is the mission of the Church in this world.

What topics are covered?

Briefly, the retreat's content includes:

- The **vocational life** of the baptized Christian;
- Elements of discerning **vocational lifestyle** (married, celibate, single); and
- Process and practical steps for **vocational discernment**. A full list of topics is available at www.awakeningvocations.com.

Other elements include:

- **Breakout time** for discussion, personal work, and socializing;
- **Testimonials** and wisdom from local guest speakers (young married couples; mature married couples; priests, members of apostolic and contemplative religious orders, seminarians and those in religious formation, and celibate and single lay men and women);
- **Sacraments** (Reconciliation; Eucharist).



What does it cost?

The **Next Step Café**, usually offered through the local Newman Center or Catholic campus ministry, typically spans Friday evening into Sunday, and includes Sunday Mass.

The usual comprehensive fee, including advance work, weekend delivery, and follow-up with recommendations, is \$2,000 plus travel. *And note . . .*

Awakening Vocations is able to adjust its usual fee to meet unusual circumstances. Please ask!

For environment, you will need an inviting meeting space large enough to accommodate the anticipated number of participants, seated at four-person café tables (card-table style is fine), and a small team gifted in transforming the space into an inviting café environment, complete with a maitre d' or host, and a friendly wait staff. Depending on the times of formal meeting, light café fare is recommended. A digital projector is preferred for PowerPoint.
